DISCUSSION

N.R.S. 280.190 requires the Fiscal Affairs Committee adopt the Funding Apportionment Plan prior to February 1 of each year. The plan is then forwarded to the participating political subdivisions with the respective governing bodies required to approve or reject that plan by March 1. If the plan is rejected, it will go to arbitration. Attached is the proposed Fiscal Year 2019-2020 plan. The plan is the statistical basis for determining the allocation of LVMPD general fund expenditures after deducting for self-generated revenue. The allocation plan identifies the distribution of Fiscal Year 2019-2020 expenditures, not offset by self-generated revenue, between the City of Las Vegas and Clark County once the budget has been approved. The apportionment will be in accordance with N.R.S. 280.201 wherein the Department will identify the functional areas to be funded and the bureaus and sections included in each of those areas.

Staff recommends approval of the Funding Apportionment Plan for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 and forwarding to respective participating political subdivisions for their consideration.
