After your vehicle delivery is complete, you can begin accessing your <u>Tesla App</u> for features such as: Keyless Driving, Range Status, Climate Control, GPS location, Valet Mode, Scheduling Service Appointments, etc.

Your Tesla.com account will not display your vehicle, as it is owned by your company / Lessor. However, you will have Tesla App access as a Driver. You should log-in to your Tesla App to save credit card details for any <u>supercharging fees</u> associated to your vehicle. In your Tesla App, please navigate to **Account Settings > Charging > Payment Method > Save a Credit Card.** 

Please **DO NOT** request an Ownership Transfer or Claim Ownership in your Tesla.com Account Settings or Customer Support, as this could prompt removal of initial-owner benefits, vehicle warranties, etc. Rest assured, you have the proper accesses to your vehicle as a Driver.

Your Tesla does not require annual maintenance and regular fluid changes. With over-the-air software updates, SmartAlerts, remote diagnostics and the support of our Mobile Service technicians, the need to visit a Service Center is reduced. For minor maintenance and repairs, <a href="step-by-step guidance">step-by-step guidance</a> is available. If additional service is needed, <a href="schedule-aservice-appointment">schedule-aservice-appointment in the Tesla App.</a>

For body or collision repair, login to the <u>Tesla App</u> and select 'Collision & Glass Repair' from the Service Menu. You will be prompted to describe the repair and upload photos to help us quickly assess the damage. If you are using insurance, please be sure to let us know your carrier and claim number. In the event we cannot perform your repair in service, we will refer you to a Tesla Body Repair Center or a Tesla Approved Body Shop.

Tesla recommends checking your tires every 6,250 miles for rotating, balancing, aligning, and/or replacement needs.


