On August 21, 2019 at approximately 2211 hours, I was on patrol in marked vehicle 15. While on patrol I observed a white Lexus, bearing NJ registration **Privac**, traveling on Collage Ave towards Senior Street without it's headlights on. I then observed the Lexus cross over the clearly marked double yellow line with both drivers' side tires in front of 130 Collage Ave. The Lexus then made a left hand turn onto Senior Street. I activated my overhead emergency lights and conducted a motor vehicle stop on Senior Street near the intersection of Easton Ave. The vehicle came to a sudden stop with the tires skidding and nearly collided with a vehicle that was also stopping in front of it.

I approached the driver's side window of the vehicle and requested his driver's license. The driver immediately handed me his registration and insurance. I requested the driver to provide me with his license again and he advised that I already had it. I advised him that I only had his registration and insurance. The driver appeared to be confused with my request and eventually located his license and provided it to me, identifying him as Stephen Demicco (not affiliated). It should be noted that Demicco's eyes were bloodshot, glassy, and watery. I also detected the odor of alcoholic beverages emanating from within the vehicle. I asked Demicco where he was coming from and he stated "downtown" I then asked Demicco if he had anything to drink and he stated a couple. I further inquired about what Demicco had to drink and he advised one bourbon and a couple of glasses of wine with dinner at The Frog and The Peach. I returned to my vehicle to secure Demicco's document and requested Acting Sgt. Roitzsch to respond to the scene for Standardized Field Sobriety Tests.

At this time, I approached the driver's side of the vehicle and requested Demicco to exit the vehicle, which he willingly complied. Demicco was escorted to a nearby concrete sidewalk that was straight, level, and free of debris. It should be noted that the area was illuminated with the use of my overhead ally lights and on scene officers hand held flashlights. All on scene vehicles emergency lights were switched to rear lights only in order to not affect the tests. While waiting for the arrival of Acting Sgt. Roitzsch I asked Demicco if he had any medical conditions, to which he responded no. While Speaking with Demicco the odor of alcoholic beverages was emanating from his mouth and his speech was slow.

Upon the arrival of Acting Sgt. Roitzsch, the Horizontal Gaze and Nystagmus was conducted. It should be noted that during this test I observed Domicco swaying back and forth. See Acting Sgt. Roitzsch supplemental report for further details.

Next, Domicco was explained the walk and turn test and was placed in the starting position, which he stepped out of the position once and failed to keep hid feet together connecting heel to toe, as instructed. Domicco was instructed on the test, stated that he understood the test, and was prompted to begin the test. Domicco missed connecting heel to toe by more than one half inch on every step on the first 9 and raised his arms more than six inches the entire time. Domicco then made an incorrect turn by just turning around to the right. Series two, Domicco Stepped of the line and missed the heel to toe connection by more than one half inch on all of the steps. Domicco also raised his arms continuously throughout the conducted tests.

Next, I instructed Domicco on the one-leg stand. At the conclusion of the instructional stage, Domicco indicated he understood. Domicco choose to raise his right foot for the test. As Domicco began the tests, he swayed noticeably on all phases of the 30 second count. Domicco also raised his arms multiple times on all phases of the 30 second count. Between the 0-10 and second phase Domicco almost fell over, placed his foot down twice and switched to his left foot. Domicco then placed his left foot down between the 11-20 portion of the test and switched to his right foot. Between the 21-30 portion of the test Domicco placed his right foot down and switched to his left foot. During the entire portion of the test Domicco was having a difficult time maintaining his balance and lifting his foot to the

instructed height. Domicco also had to be instructed multiple times to continue the test and failed to count to 30 during the test.

Domicco was placed under arrest for driving while intoxicated and his hands were secured behind his back with handcuffs (double locked). Domicco was then searched for contraband, which yielded negative results. Domicco was then placed in the rear prisoner compartment of vehicle 15 and secured with a seat belt. It should be noted the interior portion of my patrol vehicle quickly filled with the odor of alcoholic beverages. I approached the passenger side window of the vehicle and spoke with Jeanne Fox (not affiliated) and advised her that the vehicle would be have to be towed. Fox advised that she only lived a block away and walked home, as per request. Domicco was then transported to RUPD Headquarters with the MVAR activated. It should be noted that Officer Kosinski remained on scene with the vehicle. The vehicle was removed from the scene by Guaranteed Motors in good condition.

Upon our arrival to RUPD Headquarters, Domicco was escorted in to the processing area and searched again for contraband, which yielded negative results Domicco was then secured to the bench in the processing area with a single strand handcuff (double locked).

At this time, Domicco's mouth was checked for foreign objects yielding negative results. I time-stamped a 20-minute observation period with Rutgers Communications and kept time on my personal wrist watch. During the 20-minute observation Domicco did not burp, hiccup, or regurgitate any mouth alcohol and i maintained and constant face to facecontact with him from approximately 4 feet away. I read out loud to Domicco his Miranda Rights and the Attorney Generals Standard statement. Domicco indicated "yes" to a request for breath samples.

After the 20-minute observation period had ended, all electronics were removed from the room and Domicco was placed in a seated position next to the instrument. See Acting Sgt. Roitzsch's supplemental report for further details regarding the Alcotest.

The Alcotest result provided a breath sample of .09% BAC which was verified true and within tolerance by Rutgers Communications.

Fox (non-affiliated) arrived to Rutgers Police Headquarters and completed the John's Law paperwork. Fox was provided a copy of the signed form.

Domicco was released at approximately 0036 hours.

Summons Info: Domicco was issued 1214r135288, 1214r135289, 1214r135290, 1214r137861, 1214r137862, 1214r137863, and was released under the John's Law provision to Fox with the necessary paperwork and provided a court date of September 2, 2019 at 0845 hours. It should be noted that all property was returned to Domicco prior to his departure.

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Supplement #1 Narrative

On August 21, 2019 at 2211 hours, the undersigned officer responded to a motor vehicle stop on Senior Street at the intersection of Easton Avenue initiated by Officer Eric Moschberger #3962. Upon arrival, Ofc. Moschberger indicated that he suspected alcohol impairment of the driver due to observed operation of the vehicle and indicators presented by the driver. Ofc. Moschberger had asked the driver to exit the vehicle who was later identified as Stephen Demicco (non-affiliated) who was escorted to an area of the sidewalk which appeared level, free from tripping hazards and debris and illuminated by the alley lights of vehicle 15 and officer's handheld flashlights.

I introduced myself to Demicco who subsequently indicated that he consumed a "couple of bourbons and glasses of wine with dinner." at the Frog and the Peach restaurant. Demicco indicated that he did not ingest any prescription or illicit drugs prior to driving, that he did not wear glasses and was not currently wearing contacts, and that the footwear that he was currently wearing was of good soles and suitable for balance. I placed Demicco in an observable position and began Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. I preformed Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) and confirmed with Demicco that he could see the stimulus to which Demicco stated he could. The stimulus was placed approximately 12-16 inches from the medial portion of Demicco's nose. Demicco was asked with one finger to touch the end of stimulus with the pad of his finger to which he completed indicating that he understood the portion he was to follow. As Demicco was observing the stimulus, I detected no resting nystagmus, equal sized pupil and equal tracking of the stimulus. I conducted Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus observing the following six clues:

- 1) Lack of smooth pursuit in the left eye
- 2) Lack of smooth pursuit in the right eye
- 3) Nystagmus at maximum deviation in the left eye
- 4) Nystagmus at maximum deviation in the right eye

I observed Demicco to sway significantly back and forth while performing the test. At numerous points during the tests I had to remind Demicco to stop moving his head and to only follow the stimulus with his eyes. Demicco continually anticipated the position of the stimulus and would jump ahead. I observed no vertical nystagmus.

My findings were passed to Ofc. Moschberger for the purposes of the Standardized Field Sobriety Battery.

Alcotest Instrument

Upon my arrival, Rutgers Police Officer Eric Moschberger #3962 was conducting the mandatory 20 minute observation period which to my knowledge was uninterrupted and continuous. After the 20 minute observation period, had ended, Demicco was placed in a seated position next to the instrument. At that time, I began to operate the instrument, and explained to the subject the procedure he must follow prior to giving each breath sample. The same procedure was explained prior to each subsequent breath sample given. Prior to submitting to each breath sample, the subject acknowledged that he understood the instructions as given.

The subject provided valid breath samples on samples 1 and 2 and were accepted by the instrument. At each sample, I verbally explained and physically demonstrated the procedure for producing a valid breath sample. After providing two valid breath samples, which included a new mouthpiece for both breath tests, the instrument reported a breath test result of 0.09% BAC.

A DWI Computation showed the results were within acceptable tolerances (TRUE).

N.J. ATTORNEY GENERAL'S STANDARD STATEMENT FOR MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS (N.J.S.A. 39:4-50.2(e)) (revised & effective July 1, 2012)

Enter Defendant's Name STephin Demiror

The police officer shall read the following:

1. You have been arrested for driving while intoxicated. <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 39:4-50.

2. The law requires you to submit samples of your breath for the purpose of testing to determine alcohol content.

3. A record of the taking of the breath samples, including the test results, will be made. Upon your request, a copy of that record will be made available to you.

4. After you have provided samples of your breath for testing, you have the right, at your own expense, to have a person or physician of your own selection take independent samples of your breath, blood or urine for independent testing.

5. If you refuse to provide samples of your breath, you will be issued a separate summons for the refusal. A court may find you guilty of both refusal and driving while intoxicated.

6. If a court finds you guilty of the refusal, you will be subject to various penalties, including license revocation of up to 20 years, a fine of up to \$2000, installation of an ignition interlock, and referral to an Intoxicated Driver Resource Center. These penalties may be in addition to penalties imposed by the court for any other offense of which you are found guilty.

7. You have no legal right to have an attorney, physician or anyone else present for the purpose of taking the breath samples. You have no legal right to refuse to give, or delay giving, samples of your breath.

8. Any response from you that is ambiguous or conditional, in any respect, to my request that you provide breath samples, will be treated as a refusal to submit to breath testing. Even if you agree to take the test, but then do not follow my instructions, do not properly perform the test, or do not provide sufficient breath samples, I will charge you with refusal to submit to breath testing.

9. I repeat, the law requires you to submit samples of your breath for testing. Will you submit the samples of your breath?

If the arrested person does not respond, or gives any ambiguous or conditional answer short of an unequivocal "yes," the police officer shall read the following.

Your answer is not acceptable. The law requires that you submit samples of your breath for breath testing. If you do not answer, or answer with anything other than "yes," I will charge you with refusal. Now, I ask you again, will you submit to breath testing?
